Welcome and Introduction:

Dr.Apryameyan S welcomed the Chairperson and members of the committee for the meeting .

Discussion

1. Ragging has several aspects with, among others, psychological, social, political, economic, cultural, and academic dimensions.

2. Any act that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of a student should be considered within the academics related aspect of ragging

3. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a junior student by senior students should be considered an aspect of ragging for ragging economic dimensions.

4. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestured, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person ean be put in the category of ragging with criminal dimensions.

5. Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, snail-mails, blogs, public insults should be considered within the psychological aspects of ragging. This aspect would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to others.

6. the absence of preparing 'fresher's in the run up to their admission to higher education and life in hostels also can be ascribed as a psychological aspect of ragging coping skills in interaction with seniors or strangers can be imparted by parents as well. Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of students also can be described in terms of the psychological aspects of ragging.

7. The human rights perspective of ragging involves the injury caused to the fundamental right to human dignity through humiliation heaped on junior students by seniors; often resulting in the extreme step of suicide by the victims.

Action plans:

1. The punishment to be meted out to the persons indulged in ragging has to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents. The students who are found to be indulged in ragging should be debarred from taking admission in any technical institution in India.

2. Every single incident of ragging a First Information Report (FIR) must be filed without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities.

3. Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following.

(i) Cancellation of admission

(ii) Suspension from attending classes

(iii) Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits

(iv) Debarring from appearing in any test examination or other evaluation process

(v) Suspension/expulsion from the hostel

(vi) Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters

(vii) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.

(viii) Collective numshment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community



pressure on the potential raggers.

4. The institutional authority shall intimate the incidents of ragging occurred in their premises along with actions taken to the Council immediately after occurrence of such incident and inform the status of the case from time to time.

5. Courts should make an effort to ensure that cases involving ragging are taken up on priority basis to send the correct message that ragging is not only to be discouraged but also to be dealt with sternness.



- 3. Dr. Deepika Lokesh mentioned that the college must ensure that students should be able to have easy access to voicing their concerns to the GRC via efficient online or offline mode. The college needed to publicize the importance of reporting grievances at the earliest so that timely redressals could be met out.
- 4. Prof. Sujani G., mentioned that details of staff members in the GRC and the relevant government circulars and documents should be added on to the separately created portal for grievances redressal, on the webpage of the college.
- 5. The meeting concluded with the members resolving to work to the best of their abilities so as to make the working of the GRC effective.

The above-mentioned minutes have been approved by the members undersigned.

There were 3 complaints, each was addressed separately, since two of them related to harassment outside the college premises namely the government bus between Kolar and college, the principal intervened. A call was made to the respective police station to step up security and vigilance ensuring safety of the students. There has been no further incident after this intervention

The third complaint had to be investigated at a different level; there was pathology and mental illness. The parent was informed first and then the student was suspended; it was followed by psychiatric assessment intervention after consent from the student. The procedures were followed of calling the complainants conducting an inquiry. The focus was on dealing with the mental illness. After treatment and assessment follow up action the student was allowed back to college. An apology letter was given to the complainants.

There had been no further complaints after the mental illness was taken care of. The records details of the case remain confidential and property of the CBIT.



Subject: Steps to be taken for curbing the menace of ragging-reg

As you are aware, in pursuance to the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging in the AICTE approved technical Institutions, All India Council for Technical Education has framed the Regulations called All India Council for Technical Education (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institution, Universities including Deemed to be Universities imparting technical education) Regulations, 2009. These Regulations are mandatory for all AICTE approved Institution across the country.

As multiple mechanisms are required to ensure a ragging-free campus, you are requested to take/initiate following action/steps:

- Constitution of Anti-Ragging Committee (ARC), Anti-Ragging Squad (ARS), setting up of Anti-Ragging Cell and adequate publicity for these measures through various media.
- A clear mention of Anti-Ragging warning in the Institution's prospectus and information booklets/brochures shall be ensured.
- Preparation of e-admission booklet or brochure, e-leaflets of your Institutions giving detailed guidance to admitted students in case of ragging, instead of print/hard copy.
- 4. Display banners/posters at conspicuous places in the campus to create awareness on anti-ragging measures amongst student (soft copies of the 04 posters are attached). Also to display these anti-ragging posters in their website.
- Updation of websites of Institutions with the complete address and contact details of Nodal Officers related to Anti-Ragging Committee.
- 6. It is compulsory for each student and his/her parent/Guardian to submit an online anti-ragging undertaking each academic year at either of the two designated websites, namely, <u>www.antiragging.in</u> and <u>www.amanmovement.org</u> as per revised procedure. In this regard, kindly refer to AICTE's letter dated 22.11.2021 (a copy enclosed).



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- Regular interaction and counselling with the students to detect early signs of ragging and identification of trouble-triggers.
- Surprise inspection at hostels, students' accommodation, canteens, rest-cumrecreation rooms, toilets, bus-stands and any other measure which would augur well in preventing/quelling ragging and any uncalled for behaviour/incident.
- The amount arisen out of penalty/fine in ragging cases, if any, may be deposited in respective Institution and the said amount may be utilized/used for creating awareness on Anti Ragging only.
- Students in distress due to ragging related incidents can call the National Anti-Ragging Helpline at 1800-180-5522 (24x7 Toll Free Number) or e-mail the Anti-Ragging Helpline at <u>helpline@antiragging.in.</u>

In view of the above, all AICTE approved technical Institutions are hereby requested to make necessary compliance on the above. Any violation of AICTE Regulations or failure of Institution to take adequate steps to prevent ragging in accordance with these Regulations or failure to punish perpetrators of incidents of ragging suitably, will attract punitive action under the AICTE Act.
